“THE PURPOSE OF TRIALS”

JAMES 1:19-27

1. (1:19-25) Listen to God's Truth & put it into action (like two pedals on a bike)
 - a. You are loved by God! God reminds you of who you are before telling you what to do
 - b. “be quick to listen, slow to speak, slow to anger...” (Exo 34:6; Prov 10:19)
 - c. God's Word is like a truth-telling mirror
 - i. Let God's Truth redeem and replace wickedness in your life (Col 3:8; Eph 4:22-32)
 - ii. Follow His Word (NOT our “heart” emotions which can deceive us (Jer. 17:9; Prov 3:5-7); (John 17:17)
 - d. Don't just feel good “knowing” the Bible, put its truths into action (Luke 11:28; 1 Cor 8:1)
 - i. As you read the Bible, ask God to help you understand, help you apply it immediately, help you seize opportunities to do what He says
 - ii. God will bless your faithful active obedience to Him (Ps 37:4; 1 John 5:3)
2. (1:26-27) True religion? Show grace and help the vulnerable & mistreated (Lev 19:18; Ps 68:5; Isa 1:16-18)
 - a. This helps keep us humble & holy, serving others in our journey with Jesus (John 17:15; Rom 12:2; 1 Pet 2:16)
 - b. Jesus keeps us unstained (Zech.3:1-4; Rev 3:4-5), by His grace and for His glory!
